Earlage an Option for Harvesting Corn

One option for harvesting and storing corn is turning it into earlage, which ultimately will be used for cattle feed. Earlage works well in a variety of cattle diets, including growing and finishing diets for beef cattle.

However, producers should contact their crop insurance agent before harvesting their corn crop as earlage. Failure to do so may be a violation of their insurance policy and could result in significant penalties, Lardy says. [Read more from this story...](#)
